Town of Plainfield Select Board Meeting Minutes Tuesday, July 6, 2020, 7:30 AM

Jim Volz, Sasha Thayer, and Town Treasurer Linda Wells were present in person. Tammy Farnham was present by Zoom starting at 7:45 am. The meeting was called to order at 7:40 am.

Public Comment and Announcements: There was no public comment as no member of the public was present, and no announcements.

Set tax rate: The only item of business was to set the tax rate for the 2021-2011 fiscal year. Based on the figures provided by Town Treasurer Linda Wells, the motion was made by Sasha Thayer to set the resident municipal tax rate at \$0.8611. This tax rate takes in to account allocation of \$91,155.51 of surplus funds for the 2020-2021 Fiscal Year to reduce the 2021-2022 tax rate. Tammy raised the issue of moving some of the surplus funds into Town reserve funds to make any tax increase for 2022-2023 less burdensome. There are a number of designated reserve funds establishe by vote at various town meetings, including one for the Pedestrian Bridge project, but none for the Rte 2 intersection remediation project. Tammy noted that construction materials are increasing and the amount approved for the cost of the pedestrian bridge is not a fixed figure, but could be more. Tammy advocated for \$20,000 of the surplus funds to be allocated to the pedestrian bridge project. Other considerations, including that the 2021-2022 budget approved by the voters at Town Meeting included \$15,000 for the pedestrian bridge project and whether that amount should be increased by allcation of 2020-2021 surplus funds were discussed. The motion passed with Jim Volz and Sasha Thayer voting, "Aye" and Tammy Farnham voting, "No." Sasha Thayer moved that rate for resident education tax be set at 1.7599 and the non-resident education tax rate be set at 1.7683 and the motion passed unanimously. Sasha Thayer m oved that the non-resident rate for municipal taxes be set at .8611 and the motion passed unanimously. This sets a combined resident tax rate of \$2.621 and a combined non-resident tax rate of \$2.6294.

Tammy Farnham moved to adjourn the meeting and the motion passed unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 8:17 AM.
