Plainfield Planning Commission Meeting

October 21st 2019

Agenda: Town Plan Revision

Bram made the motion to approve the minutes of the previous meeting and Jesse seconded it. The motion was approved.

Bram made some revisions to chapter 8 and is waiting for more data to finish.

Sarah will speak with Clare next week about the maps. She thinks the maps that are on file with CVRPC will be the best for the least cost.

She updated the goals in strategies to the current status.

Bram mentioned that perhaps the plan should mention something about commercial drone deliveries to residencies. The reasoning would be to preserve the character of the town. His suggestion is that the town could control where the drone lands, not necessarily having the town control the airspace.

Sarah asked about some of the class 4 roads and how they should be considered in the plan.

Bram gave an update on the Thompson Road which is anticipated to be designated as a trail. It was supposedly "thrown up" but in this case it actually didn't happen.

The strategy in the plan is to recommend not "throwing up" (giving up the town right of way) the road but downgrading the right of way to a trail. This is what is expected to happen for the Thompson Road.

Jesse will send the updated Housing section to Bram to incorporate into the master copy. Jesse also sent the updated Economic Section to Bram.

Bram will post the new version to Claire for review and then the draft will got out for a hearing.
