

## **Plainfield Social Concerns Committee**

### **Minutes**

**December 2, 2018**

After public notice, the Social Concerns Committee met to consider applications for 2019 Town funding and make funding recommendations. The committee reviewed all the applications that were submitted to the Town Clerk and made recommendations for funding based upon number of Plainfield residents served, past level of funding, importance of the services for meeting health and welfare needs of Plainfield residents, and other sources of funds available to the organization.

The Committee recommended that every application but one be funded. (see spreadsheet for specifics). Central Vermont Economic Development was not recommended for funding because the committee did not think it offered the types of health, safety, and welfare needs that the Social Concerns Committee is intended to address.

After discussion, the Committee was able to agree on all recommendations, except that Sarah Albert would have funded Twin Valley Senior Center at a lower level because it received such a large increase in funding for 2018.
